




ST EDMUND OF CANTERBURY

Translation of St Edmund, 9th June: Brentwood, Portsmouth, Old Hall

Feast of St Edmund, 16th November: Westminster, Brentwood, Portsmouth The feast also celebrated in Birmingham, Clifton, Liverpool, Leeds, Middlesbrough, Northampton, Plymouth, Salford, Shrewsbury & Southwark, not with these propers but using the Common *Statuit ei Dominus (Liber Usualis 1182ff)*.







In Eastertide the Gradual and Alleluia are replaced with the Alleluia 'Tu es sacerdos' followed by the Alleluia 'Hic est sacerdos' (Liber Usualis 1183-4).
